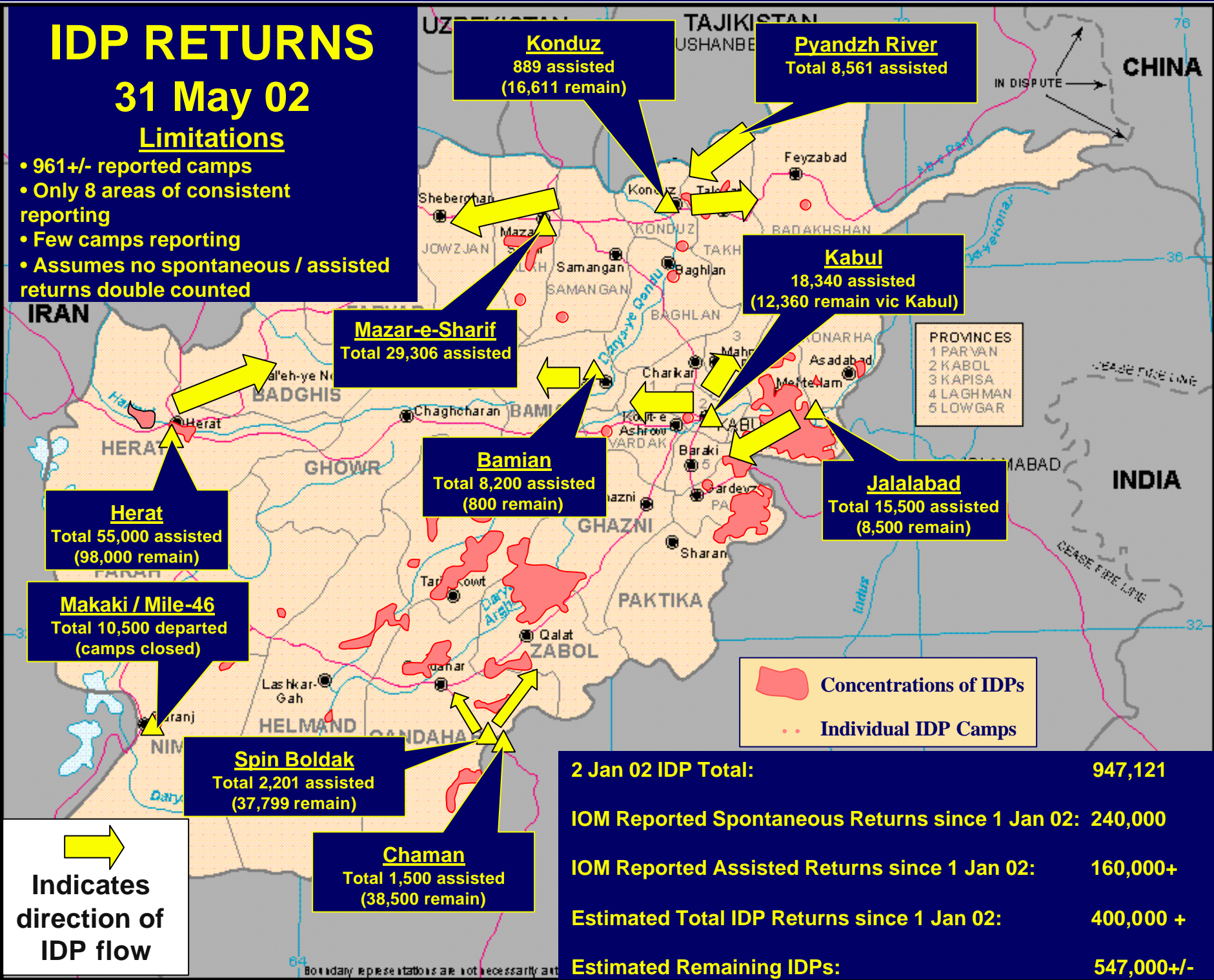


IDP RETURNS
