FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007

The following is a summary of the financial operations of the Women's Commission for Refugee Women and Children for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2007. This summary is compiled from numbers presented in the 2007 annual financial statement of the International Rescue Committee, Inc. (IRC). The Women's Commission is legally part of the IRC, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization. Charitable contributions made to the IRC and to the Women's Commission are tax deductible. However, the Women's Commission receives no direct financial support from the IRC. 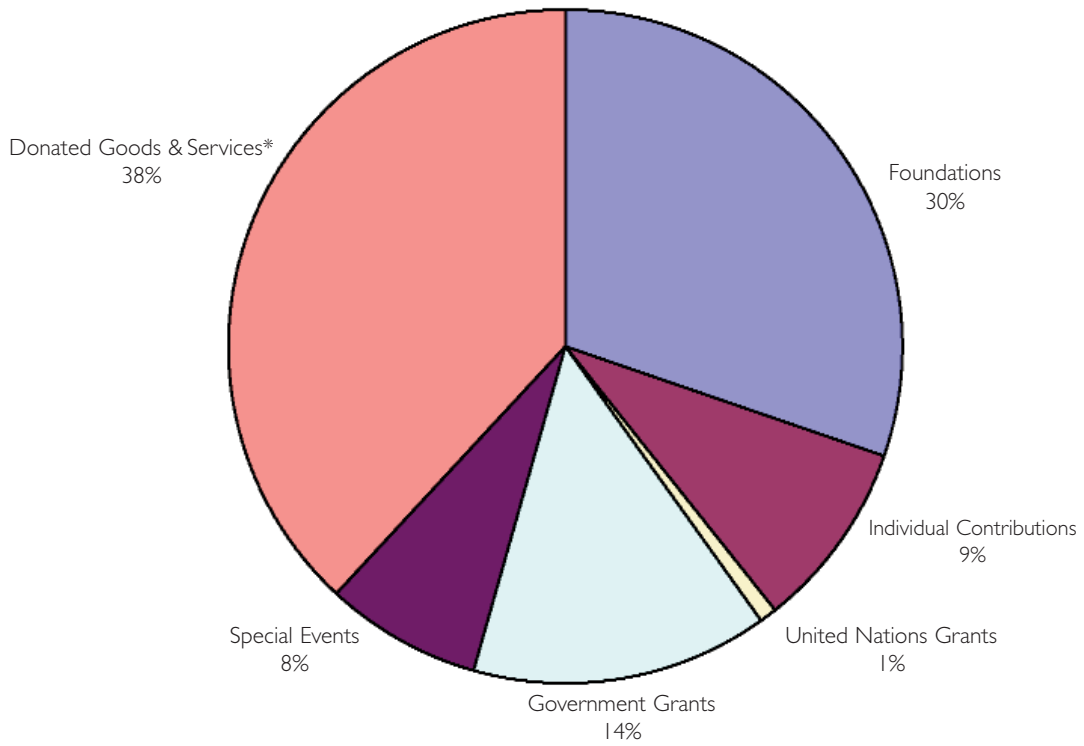

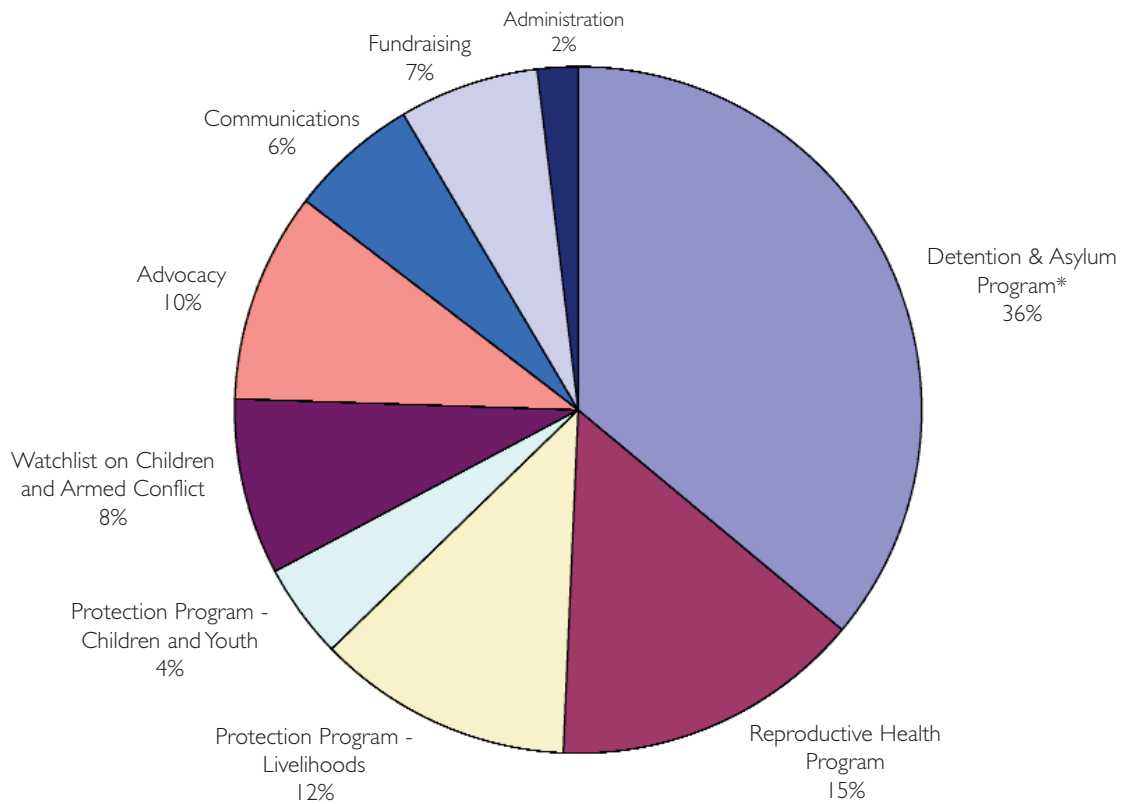
