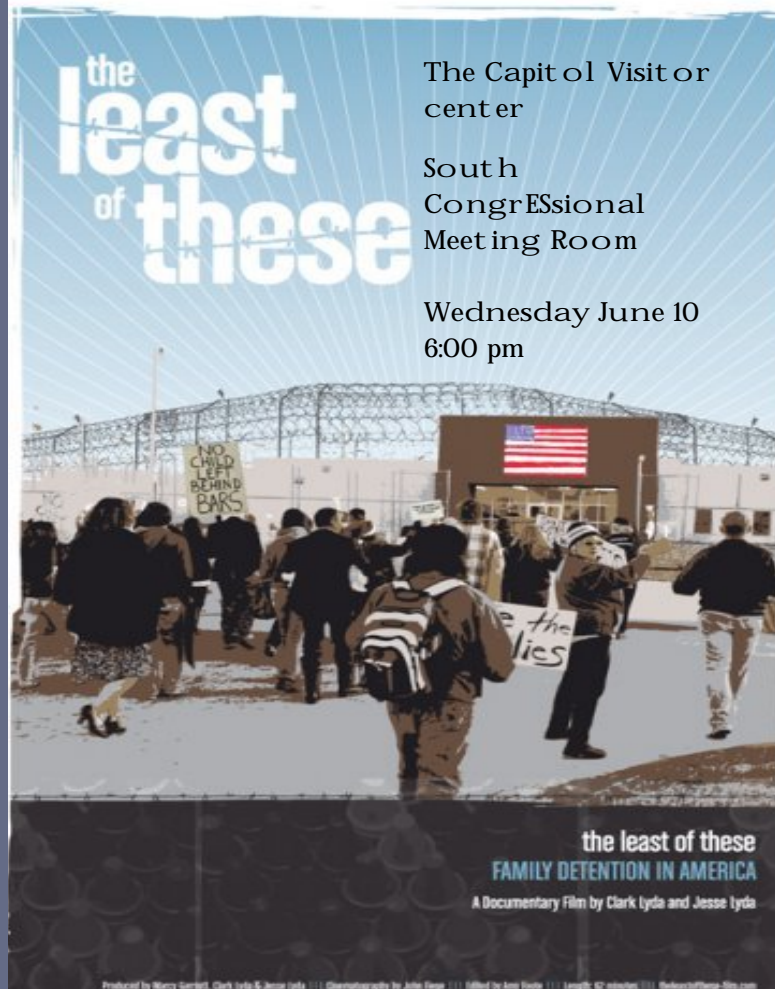


Special Alert: Congressional Screening of Documentary on Family Detention
