



Sudan National-Level Workshop: “Mitigating Risk of Gender-Based Violence” *Implementing Economic and Household Energy Programs as Tools of Protection*

March 2-5, 2010 in Juba, Sudan

Join us for a workshop for economic and gender-based violence staff from governments, donor agencies, and NGOs working in Sudan to acquire knowledge and hands-on skills necessary to implement and evaluate economic and household energy programs that will reduce displaced women’s vulnerability to gender-based violence. The workshop is limited to 25 participants.

This is a participatory four-day, national-level workshop. It will engage participants to develop market-oriented, context-specific approaches and protection strategies for designing safe and self-reliant livelihood and household interventions to benefit returning refugees and the internally displaced in Sudan. The workshop will include practice sessions and will help in adapting participant project work plans. A joint action plan to support collaboration and coordination between participants will be developed. Participants will have continued access to the Women’s Refugee Commission’s staff for technical assistance through 2011.
